This Year We Are Offering Two Choices! The Full 14 Day Trip, As Well As a Shorter 11 Day Version.

Option 1 (14 Day): Saturday, October 3 - Friday, October 16, 2009

Option 2 (11 Day): Saturday, October 3 – Tuesday, October 13, 2009

Join Family Adoption Consultants on its 2nd annual China Orphanage Service Project as we assist children with special needs at an orphanage outside Beijing, China! Volunteers are needed! Individuals can assist in either of two capacities. One, to assist in working on a facilities project at the orphanage. Two, to assist the workers at the orphanage in caring for the children. All can help in this important endeavor!

Costs: * 14 Day Option: \$700

11 Day Option: \$600

Please make checks payable to FAC. (This includes all "in- country" expenses, such as food, transportation, housing. Bring extra money for shopping!)

* Airline ticket to Beijing, China (Purchased and coordinated by the individual. Common airlines used are Northwest, Continental, and United.)

* Visa to enter China (Typically \$180 coordinated through a courier. Purchased and coordinated by the individual.)

Itinerary: Saturday, October 3 – Flights to Beijing.

Sunday, October 4 – Arrival in Beijing!

Monday, October 5 – Shopping, touring, and jet lag recovery!

Tuesday, October 6 – Travel to Yanjiao (35 kilometers east of Beijing). Visit to Living Tree Orphanage.

Wednesday, October 7 – Work at Living Tree Orphanage.

Thursday, October 8 – Work at Living Tree Orphanage.

Friday, October 9 – Work at Living Tree Orphanage.

Saturday, October 10 – Work at Living Tree Orphanage.

Sunday, October 11 – Work at Living Tree Orphanage.

Monday, October 12 – Folks participating in 11 day option travel back to Beijing for additional shopping before flights home the next day. Folks participating in 14 day option continue work at Living Tree Orphanage.

Tuesday, October 13 – Flights back home to the States for 11 day option. Folks in the 14 day option travel to Zhao Xian (about 4 hours south of Beijing) to assist at second orphanage.

Wednesday, October 14 – Work at Zhao Xian Orphanage.

Thursday, October 15 – Travel back to Beijing for 14 day option for additional shopping and touring prior to flights home the next day.

Friday, October 16 - Flights back home for 14 day option.

Housing will be provided to all participants in the China Service Project at special housing that has been built for the upcoming Olympics in Beijing. To look at this housing, go to:
